The SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY INFORMATION INSTITUTE (STII) hereinafter referred to as "Implementing Agency," a government entity and an attached agency of the DOST, duly existing and created as the information and marketing arm of the DOST by virtue of Executive Order No. 128 with principal office address at DOST Compound, General Santos Avenue, Bicutan 1631, Taguig City, Metro Manila and represented herein by its director, MR. RICHARD P. BURGOS; for the implementation of the above-cited project.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned project was approved by the DOST-PCAARRD Director's Council Meeting on December 15, 2020 via Zoom Cloud Meeting;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the PARTIES hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

> I. OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

The general objective of the project is to hasten the establishment of the Knowledge Network of eLibraries using SLIMS as a common portal for agriculture, aquatic, and natural resources (AANR) generated from DOST-PCAARRD-supported projects and created by its stakeholders.

Specifically, the project aims to:

Enhance/improve the SLIMS feature to be more user-friendly;

b. Facilitate easy access of AANR resources using the mobile app of the SLIMS

Online Public Access Catalog (OPAC);

c. Make accessible to the public the journal articles and other knowledge resources generated from different DOST-PCAARRD-supported projects and created by its stakeholders;

d. Capacitate consortia library personnel on the use and administration of SLIMS; and

e. Promote and market the DOST-PCAARRD eLibrary.

II. OPERATION OF THE PROJECT

The project shall be undertaken by the Implementing Agency in accordance with the approved project proposal (made part hereof as Annex "A") and the Revised DOST-GIA Guidelines (A.O. 011 Series of 2020) and shall be monitored in accordance with the DOST A.O. 014 Series of 2019 - DOST M&E Protocol.

III. FUNDING ASSISTANCE TO THE PROJECT

The Funding Agency shall provide grant in the amount of FOUR MILLION NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT PESOS and EIGHTY CENTAVOS (P4,987,568.80) for 12 months to be expended as allocated in the approved Project Line-Item Budget (made part hereof as Annex "B"). The Guidelines on the Grants-in-Aid Program (made part hereof as Annex "C") shall govern the implementation of the Project.

The activities, operation of books of accounts and records of the project shall be subject to inspection by the authorized representatives of the Funding Agency and its auditor, whenever necessary. GIA assistance shall be discontinued for any violation of the Grant Agreements such as fraud or falsity in the Program/Project Leader's proposal, representation and warranties; when the results obtained do not justify further activity; or non-compliance or late submission of requirements by the Implementing Agency resulting in funds becoming unavailable. The Project Leader shall be notified at least forty-five (45) days before the date of termination.

All income/interest derived from the program/project, if any, and all unexpended balance shall be reported and reverted to the Funding Agency within three (3) months after the end of project period.

IV. PROJECT DURATION

The project shall be implemented for twelve (12) months. It shall commence on the date specified in the approved line-item budget or immediately upon but not later than two (2) months after the release of funds.

FUND RELEASE AND UTILIZATION

The financial grant shall be released by the Funding Agency to the Implementing Agency, subject to availability of funds, and accounting and auditing regulations.

The Implementing Agency shall abide by the applicable rules and regulations on disbursement and utilization as mandated by the Funding Agency, to include in particular but not be limited to, rules on direct and indirect costs.

VI. PROJECT PROPERTIES

Project References: Mention of above-stated program/project in any and all publication, literature and information material in whatever media form shall state reference to PCAARRD as Funding Agency and STII as Implementing Agency.

Intellectual Property (IP): Ownership and utilization of IPs and Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) resulting from the project shall be governed by the Philippine Technology Transfer Act of 2009. The Implementing Agency and the Program/Project Leader acknowledge that they have read, understood and hereby agree to be bound by the provisions of the said Act. In case of conflict with other laws, rules or regulations, the said Act shall prevail.

Records of Equipment: The Property Officer/s of the Funding and Implementing Agencies shall establish a complete and centralized file of records of all equipment procured through DOST-assisted programs/projects which shall include the following: agency name, location of equipment, project title, current custodian or end-user accountable for the equipment, equipment purchased with description/specification, date of acquisition, property number and acquisition/actual cost. The said Property Officer of the Funding and Implementing Agencies shall update the directory and records of equipment every year based on Property Acknowledgment Receipt (PAR) and DOST Form 10-Project Monitoring and Field Evaluation Report submitted or Property Transfer Report (PTR)/Deed of Donation issued by the Funding Agency. Inventory of equipment shall be conducted by the Funding Agency during the implementation of the project.

Ownership of Equipment: All equipment purchased through grant funds are considered as government equipment owned by DOST. These may be transferred to the Implementing Agency or other implementers. The ownership of equipment may be transferred to the Implementing Agency or private institutions, upon completion of the program/project, subject to existing rules and regulations. The Funding Agency reserves the right to transfer ownership of such government equipment to government RDIs, HEIs or other private institutions through Property Transfer Reports (PTRs) or execution of Deed/s of Donation in compliance with existing government accounting and auditing laws, rules and regulations.

In the unlikely event that the person signing for the other party is not authorized to do so, the latter agrees to hold the other party/ies harmless for any cause or consequence of the absence/lack of authority to sign.

Arbitration: All disputes arising between and among the parties as to interpretation, operation or effect of any clause in the Agreement or any other difference between the parties shall first be resolved amicably. In case of failure, the Rules on Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) between national government agencies under Republic Act No. 9285 shall apply.

Indemnification: Each party shall indemnify, hold free and harmless, and defend at its own expense the other party/ies from and against all suits, claims, demands, and liabilities of any nature or kind, arising out of acts or omissions of the former, in the performance of any activity in connection with the Project, including those that may be initiated by its employees, workers, agents, subcontractors, or by any other entity or persons against said party by reason of or in connection to the program/project.

Venue: The parties further agree that in case of legal action requiring court litigations that may arise in the enforcement of this Agreement, the venue of court litigation shall be in the Court of Competent Jurisdiction sitting in Taguig City only.

Separability Clause: If any part or provision of this Agreement is held invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in force and in effect.

IX. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS AND POLICIES

II. PROJECT SUMMARY

(7) Rationale (Not to exceed one page)

Over the years, DOST-PCAARRD has produced and funded a great number of AANR publications in the form of books, technical reports, journal articles, monographs, and IEC materials. However, a great number of these have not been easily accessible to users in the absence of any properly organized and catalogued process for public use. To maximize the utilization of these AANR knowledge resources, there is a need to organize and process these resources following a standard format for easy access and retrieval.

The establishment of the DOST-PCAARRD Knowledge Network of eLibraries shall be carried out for that purpose. This Knowledge Network shall organize, catalog, digitize, and make AANR knowledge resources more accessible through the use of the Science Library Information Management System (SLIMS). Network members shall encode the bibliographic data and upload the full text of the AANR resources and knowledge products in the SLIMS server. Consequently, contents of the SLIMS serverwill be accessible to public in a common portal through DOST-PAARRD eLibrary OPAC at the moment of value.

The project also aims to enhance SLIMS's features and functionalities to make it continually responsive to the needs of the network. Moreover, this library management system shall also support the DOST-

ScINET Phil, as one of its members or node(?)thus contributing AANR S&T content to the Philippine eLib portal.

(8) Project Description (Not to exceed 15 pages)

This proposed project seeks to hasten the establishment of a DOST-PCAARRD Knowledge Network of eLibraries to facilitate the organization, digitization, processing, and resource sharing of AANR resources among the stakeholders and make them more broadly accessible online. The benefits of establishing this kind of network are as follows: 1) It helps avoid duplication of efforts and provide efficiency savings, streamline work processes, and free up time for more value added activities; 2) It increases the profile and visibility of a network library beyond its traditional user-base as well as foster greater appreciation of the professional skills and knowledge of the people serving the said library; 3) It helps provide a more joined up service delivery, with a single user interface to different services or a reduction in the number of times data inputs is required; and 4) it promotes development of innovative solutions to common problems such as unorganized and inaccessible library titles.

Commitment to the Knowledge Network may need to be documented in a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for greater clarity and transparency among all partners institutions, particularly in populating the SLIMS server with AANR content. The criteria of AANR resources and/or knowledge products to be included in the SLIMS shall be clearly defined in the Collection Development Policy to ensure the integrity of the database. The Knowledge Network of eLibraries shall follow the structure below.




Figure 1. Organizational Structure of the DOST-PCAARRD Knowledge Network of eLibraries

This Network seeks to support the information requirements of its target audience and stakeholders at the national, regional and municipal levels. It aims to promote and improve the flow and use of AANR information and knowledge products through active resource sharing and networking through the use of SLIMS and accessed through the DOST-PCAARRD eLibrary Online Public Access Catalog. In the future it may expand linkages with other AANR information centers or government departments with AANR interest. The network also develops human resources capability for information and related works.

The Knowledge Network of eLibraries follows an organizational structure chaired by the Director of DOST-PCAARRD and Vice chaired by the Director of DOST-STII. The DOST-PCAARRD as the hub for AANR center and chair of the Knowledge Network of eLibraries shall support the technical committee (the regional consortia). The support may be in terms of funding project proposals of the technical committee (the regional consortia) to accomplish their role/functions as content builders of SLIMS and promoters of the AANR resources and knowledge products accessible through the DOST-PCAARRD eLibrary OPAC.

The DOST-STII as the Vice-chair and implementing agency of this project will assist in mentoring, coaching and capacitating the technical committee to organize their AANR resources using SLIMS depending on their needs as stated in their project proposal.

The Technical Committee is composed of designated representative from the technical staff of each consortium. This committee is in charge of planning and implementation of the activities of the network. They may ask help from DOST-PCAARRD through consultation and project proposal base.

The Secretariat is comprised of the staff of the DOST-PCAARRD eLibrary. They will assist the Technical Committee in project implementation or accomplishing the activities of the network. The Secretariat reviews and refines the project proposal for presentation to the DOST-PCAARRD Director's Council.

Objectives: (General and Specific)

The project aims to hasten the establishment of the Knowledge Network of eLibraries using SLIMS as a common portal for AANR resources generated from DOST-PCAARRD-supported projects by its stakeholders.

Specifically, it aims to:

- a. Enhance/improve the SLIMS feature to be more user-friendly;
- Facilitate easy access of AANR resources using the mobile app of the SLIMS Online Public Access Catalog;
- Make accessible to the public the journal articles and other knowledge resources generated from different DOST- PCAARRD-supported projects and created by its stakeholders;
- d. Capacitate consortia library personnel on the use and administration of SLIMS; and
- e. Promote and market the DOST-PCAARRD eLibrary.

Methodology:

This project will be implemented using the following strategies:

- a. Troubleshoot/fix system error of SLIMS based on the suggestions and comments of the base agency/consortia librarians;
- b. Develop mobile app for SLIMS OPAC to facilitate easy access of AANR resources;
- Encode bibliographic data and upload full text of journal articles and other resources created or sponsored by DOST-PCAARRD and its consortia in SLIMS;
- d. Conduct trainings to capacitate the consortia member-agency library staff on the use and administration of the enhanced SLIMS with mobile app; and
- e. Develop a communication plan to generate buy-in of the PCAARRD stakeholders on the eLibrary system and promote further appreciation and access among users/patrons.

Expected Outputs:

Products:

- A functional SLIMS server with DOST-PCAARRD to serve as the hub for AANR Knowledge Center and the regional network of eLibraries as nodes
- · A user-friendly SLIMS with mobile app for handy OPAC search

- SLIMS Manual for Regional Consortia eLibraries
- Communication resources such as IEC materials to support buy-in of stakeholders and further access and appreciation of library users/patrons

Discussion on the results of related project handled by the same proponent (if any)

DOST-STII, a leading repository of S&T information in the Philippines, spearheaded the development of a library management system for DOST libraries through the DOST-ScINET-Phil network. Because member libraries used different applications in managing their library resources. In 2001, a standard digital library system, ScINET-Phil Integrated Library Management System (SILMS) was developed integrating the requirements of the ScINET-Phil consortium.

It also implemented the project," *Establishing the DOST-PCAARRD Innovation Technology Center* (DPITC)eLibrary," where it customized the SciNet Integrated Library Management System (SILMS) into the Science Library Integrated Management System (SLIMS) in October 2017-April 2019. The project also initiated the conversion of the physical library materials of DOST-PCAARRD library into digital format. It also started populating the overall SLIMS server at the DOST-PCAARRD with PCAARRD publications as initial content. This was the 1st phase of this current proposal.

In May 2019 to present, the DOST-STII continues to implement Phase 2 of DPITC eLibrary under the KM4AANR Program entitled, "Establishing DOST-PCAARRD Knowledge Networks of eLibraries." This phase aims to deploy and install SLIMS in the 15 DOST-PCAARRD consortia. It also aims to familiarize the DOST-PCAARRD consortia base-agency libraries and CMI library personnel on the management and use of SLIMS. This phase continued the conversion of AANR resources at DOST-PCAARRD library and also continued populating the overall SLIMS server with the publications and library collections of DOST-PCAARRD for easy access, retrieval, and to facilitate resource-sharing among its consortia members, to the rest of DOST agencies, and other government offices or departments with AANR interest.

(9) Work plan(See Form B)

(10) Project Management (not to exceed one page)

This project will be implemented by DOST-STII through PCAARRD-GIA funding. DOST-STII as the implementing agency will hire the required project staffs that include SRS II to develop and lead the communication plan/strategies, and IEC materials to promote the DOST-PCAARRD eLibrary through social media and tri-media. She/he will package/write, edit, and layout DOST-PCAARRD eLibrary IEC materials such as posters, flyers, leaflets, and brochures. She/he will also create social media contents for uploading to the PCAARRD FB page and coordinate tri-media collaboration/output.

The current one (1) SRS II deployed at DOST-PCAARRD eLibrary will be retained. Concerned staff shall be tasked with accessioning, classifying, cataloging of AANR publications. He also creates bibliographic records in SLIMS, assigns subject headings and cross references, and uploads full text to SLIMS. Moreover, he manages the AANR resources-organizing, labelling, and shelving as well as performs reference service to library customers.

Two (2) Computer Programmers II will be hired to maintain/troubleshoot the SLIMS database at DOST-PCAARRD and the 15 regional consortia. Enhance/fine tune SLIMS feature for easier and efficient use. Part of enhancing the SLIMS is the development of a mobile app of the SLIMS OPAC for easy access of AANR resources and information. They will also study the database structure of the existing library management system of the base agency libraries for migration of the bibliographic data of AANR resources to SLIMS. They will transfer/consolidate the content of the local host SLIMS server from the consortia libraries to the overall SLIMS server at DOST-PCAARRD as Knowledge Center for AANR resources.

The two (2) Project Assistants I in charge of scanning all AANR resources at 300-400 DPI bitonal and 24-bit colored (using text mode) and save images as PDF with right density and contrast will be retained. They organized scanned materials by material type. They do quality review to the digitized materials with highest quality. They edit images-compress files, and sharpen images.

The project will hire one (1) Clerk III to be deployed at DOST-STII to assists in monitoring attendance of the project staff. Concerned staff will assist in preparing contracts and payroll, performs clerical and admin tasks pertaining to the project.

The project will also procure the following equipment: a) one heavy duty book scanner to convert DOST-PCAARRD eLibrary resources into digital format; b)two high-end laptops to be used in enhancing SLIMS features; c) two complete set of computer units for the project staff; and d) computer software needed in the design and layout of IEC materials.

Semi-annual progress report shall be submitted to DOST-PCAARRD to report status and progress of the project. Meeting with DOST-PCAARRD shall be conducted to discuss issues and concerns as needs arise.

Monitoring activities to assess how the project is being implemented shall also be conducted to determine the actual status and progress of the project's activities and prepare a catch-up plan, if necessary.
